Chinese martial arts, known in Mandarin as Wu Shu (武术) and popularly as Kung Fu (功夫) (1) _____ a number of fighting styles that were developed over the centuries. Those fighting styles can be classified according to common themes that are identified as (2) “_____” (家), “sects” (派) or “families” (门派) of martial arts. Examples of themes are physical exercises that mimic movements from animals or a (3) _____ and training method that gather inspiration from various Chinese philosophies, myths and legends. Styles which (4) _____ qì manipulation are labeled as internal (内家拳), while others concentrate on improving muscle and cardiovascular fitness are labeled external (外家拳). Geographical association, as in Northern (北拳) and Southern (南拳), is an example of another popular method of categorization. Each fighting style (5) _____ a different approach to the common problems of self-defense, health, and self-cultivation from a Chinese perspective.

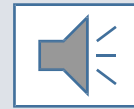

When it comes to Chinese Kung Fu, there is one name ever-present with the world. His name is Bruce Lee. It was he who (7) _____ Chinese Kung Fu to the whole world. Chinese-American Kung Fu master Bruce Lee, whose agile movements **introduced** in a series of his great movies swept American audiences off their feet. And soon the entire world was enchanted by the magic act, starting the upsurge of interest in Chinese Kung Fu. (8) _____, Chinese Kung Fu learners can be found everywhere. Now, Lee's followers, Jackie Chan (Cheng Long) and Jet Li (Li Lianjie) **From then on** carry the baton, pushing themselves to novel heights. Kung Fu films have popularized traditional Chinese martial arts throughout the world.

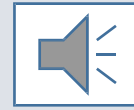

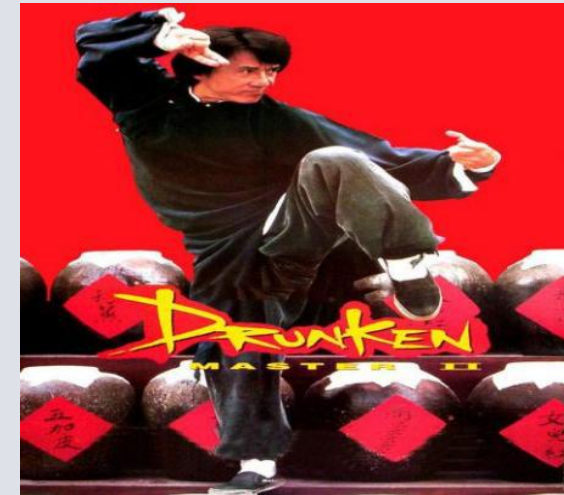

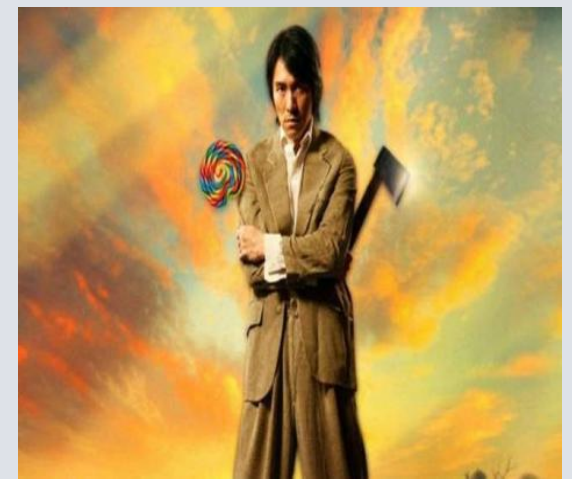
