


A: Are you free this weekend? A exhibition of paper cutting will be on at Li Zijian Art Museum this Saturday.










Pic.2Tang Dynasty (618-907)

Figure painting flourished in Tang palace. It is characterized by drawing the outline of figure with delicate black lines. The details in the painting were filled with brilliant colors and delicate brushwork.



pic.3: Song Dynasty (960-1279)

There were more subtle landscapes in the painting. The immeasurable distance is conveyed by the use of fuzzy outlines, the disappearance of mountain outlines in fog. The effect of long distance is dealt by the impressionist treatment of natural

Pic.4: Ming Dynasty (1368-1644)

There is a simple traditional theme in Chinese painting such as a fruit, some flowers, or one or two strong horses. Narrative painting has a wider range of colors and more complicated composition than that in Song dynasty.



pic.5: Qing Dynasty (1616-1911)

Painters who were known as "individualists," opposed many traditional painting rules and found ways to express themselves more directly through free brushwork.
